Exam make-up assignments

This assignment is optional. Successful completion will make Hiro change your exam scores (to make them better), and will also be good preparation for the final exam.

Prompt. Choose one problem from an exam that is *not* a multiple choice, true/false, or definition problem.

Write an answer key to the problem, with explanations. This does not mean simply writing out correct work as you would on an exam; it means that you should write helpful commentary so that somebody reading your submission could learn how to solve the problem, too.

A perfect submission will get you back 10 points on the exam in which you found the problem. (Regardless of how many points the problem was actually worth.)

You may write the solution for **at most three** problems per exam. In other words, if you choose three problems from each exam, and write a perfect explanatory solution for each, you will get back 60 points total.

Submission instructions: Please submit all of your solutions in a single **PDF file** to the appropriate Exam Make-up Assignment on Canvas. So, if you want to submit three problems' worth of solutions to Exam One, you can, but all three have to be in a single PDF file. This will ensure that I do not overlook any of your submissions.

(Your submission for Exam Two should be in a separate PDF file from your Exam One submissions—the assignments will be separate on Canvas.)
